

## **De l'adverbe *là* narratif au connecteur *Et là* consécutif**

From the French narrative adverb *là* to the consecutive connector *Et là*

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**Abstract:** If the French adverb *là* “of opening” (Barb ris, 1989) have already attracted attention, this study shows, on the one hand, that this *là*, which we will call “narrative”, can be interpreted as a temporal deictic of the story, and, on the other, that this *là* forms with the conjunction *et*, which thematizes it without imposing a strong syntactic link on it, a compound connector specialized in the expression of consecutiveness in self-narrative texts, which suppose that a voice recounts past events.
